- 3. Reports from members of the Executive Committee
 - O President
 - Meeting with Dean Ross
 - expressed concern for students, content with outgoing process
 - Meeting with Assistant Dean Brown
 - Assistant Dean of registrarial and student services

- cares a lot about student experience, wants to know how students &
 MISC feel about what we can do with her
 - O wants ideas for collaboration specifically in terms of student experience and support by faculty members, student peer support groups
 - O wants to come to a council meeting in December?
- Question how much control does she have over course enrollment?
 - O A: No control over structure, but some leeway with the details
 - O Chelsea at GSU rep dinner says multiple programs have problems with course enrollment, maybe talk to SGS
- Student Lounge Security
 - three non-ischool individuals have been identified in the lounge and two have stolen items.
 - Please don't prop open the door. Since fobs are free, access should not be a problem for students.
 - Question are fobs mandatory? Do first years know about it?
 - O They may still be poorly marketed
 - Comment can we put a sign on the door?
 - O A: yes, shortly
 - Comment overhearing undergrads wanting to get into lounge there are a lot of non-ischool students in the building for classes
- perhaps MISC will get an update about inforum renovation from Cara Krmpotich soon
- O Vice President
 - Part-time students working group event
 - co-chairing with Stephanie Abba, will be Wed Nov 25, 5-6:30
 - part time student contacted chairs, may volunteer
 - Update on collaborative event with SEC, Queer@iSchool
 - Will be in January & geared toward inclusive resources for info professionals
 - MISC office hours/student concerns
 - volunteering to hold general office hours to increase reach and approachability
 - Question office or lobby for visibility or confidentiality
 - if certain portfolios are coming up, the chairs can be asked to do hours

- MISC meeting times available to all students
 - we need enough advance notice to put them on the calendar.
 - O Chris it's a problem with the calendar, but will make an effort to advertise meetings and organize them sooner
- O Secretary
 - Webmaster and Secretary got access to the file uploads on the public website, so now the minutes are up to date there in addition to the drive
- O Treasurer
 - GSU Head Grant
 - Received very last minute notice about GSU Head Grant.
 - reiterating the grant is linked to attendance, and the GSU reps really need to attend meetings
 - Also conducting an internal audit met with last year's treasurer Lucy audit exemption is due at end of December
- O Webmaster
 - helping PD prepare page for employer showcase
 - Still requires information from new members to put on council members page!
- 4. Reports from the chairs of standing committees
 - O Academic Affairs
 - receiving emails, and redirecting students to appropriate resource.
 - some representatives not understanding their (lack of) power, but next year there won't be many students who remember previous instructions
 - meeting with David as programs committee representative about ways that reports can be better - because programs committee is also discussing issues with evaluations
 - looking for a time for pizza for the class reps
 - Chris please bring Barb Brown into programs committee/survey conversation
 - Chelsea how can we get class reps to do announcements?
 - A: They are supposed to be personally inviting faculty to iBall, it's hit-and-miss whether they follow through, and only appropriate to advertise certain events this way
 - O Social

- iBall now just for MI students, since PhDs and MUSSA were receptive of being invited but would not contribute money or work. Please invite faculty you know. iCrawl planning is underway
- therapy dogs/puppies are being passed on to mental health working group
- looking into a surprise free coffee day
 - next semester the VP will do free coffee
- in January there will be trivia
 - probably on Friday will continue to vary nights after a low turnout on a Thursday, and big events will not be on Fridays
- Chelsea are there still guest tickets to iBall?
 - A: they are \$11.20, each person is restricted to one guest, and faculty want just students to be there

O Professional Development

- Poster Workshop December 2, 4-5:30 in 417 with a speaker from the science library so students can make posters for spring conferences
- linked event in late January about how to go to a conference, probably on a Wednesday
- Employer Showcase 15th of January, in the Inforum,
 - soliciting employers if you have anyone you want to see, let PD know
- applied for SGS grant to get money to do headshots did not get the grant
 - should we spend our own money? Have quotes for photographers to set up a mini studio, take one or two shots for each student, and format for LinkedIn
 - BIRT the PD budget be increased by \$1000 for the purpose of a photoshoot for students at the employer showcase
 - O moved by Julia, seconded by Shevaun
 - O Discussion:
 - will only be at the employer showcase
 - is OLA offering the same service?
 - but other concentrations won't be there
 - will be entirely free for students
 - student survey shows professional development is important
 - would we prefer business cards instead?
 - also sourced at 27.99 for 250 cards cheaper than student services
 - O vote carries
- received email from the restarted iJournal for an SSI (Single Student Initiative) request they want \$7 for posters

- BIRT misc shall grant a one time grant of 7\$ to the iJournal for advertising expenses
 - O moved by Julia, seconded by Tristan.
 - O Discussion: can this be combined for a larger amount?
 - they are planning a bigger request for the launch party
 - O vote carries
- received concerns about events being only for MI and ARM students
 - offered organizational and financial support if they have any ideas

- Made a survey, comments varied
 - concrete requests included visible text instead of a logo, full zip hoodies, and button ideas on tshirts
 - results on google drive
 - Comment the listserv used shouldn't have worked MISC can send the survey from their account to get more responses
- proposed new prices
 - pens buy one get one free, get metallic pens next
 - megs, notebooks \$5. in comparison to staples and bookstore
 - water bottles, tshirts, usb \$10
- looking at printing/licensing, and bookstore seems the best option
 - proposed new order: shirts, hoodies, mugs, reusable bags, hats, total cost \$2500 - budget increase to \$2700?
 - mockups will be posted on drive when received next week
- Comment can we do more inventory and sell old stuff?
- Comment the process should go on hold for new survey results and feedback about mockups
