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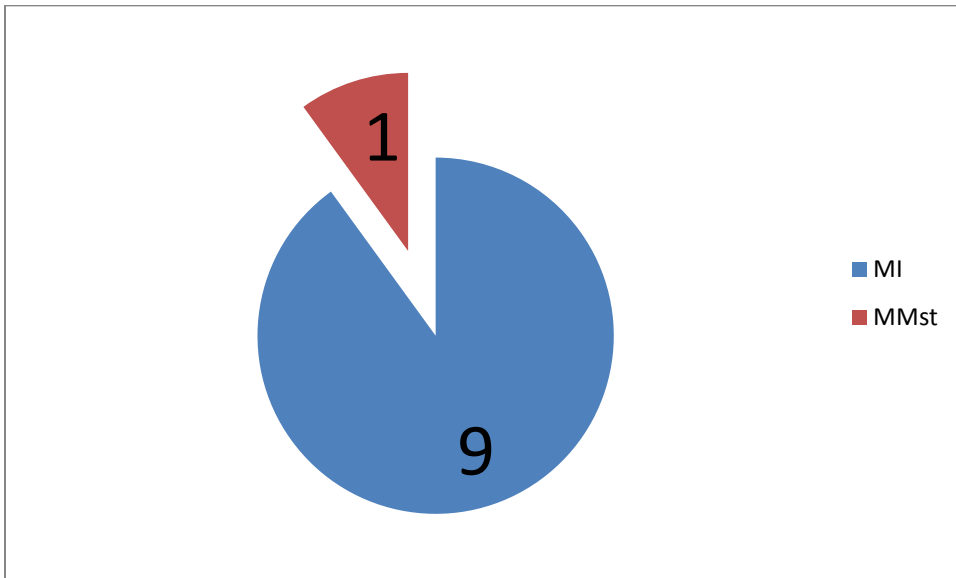

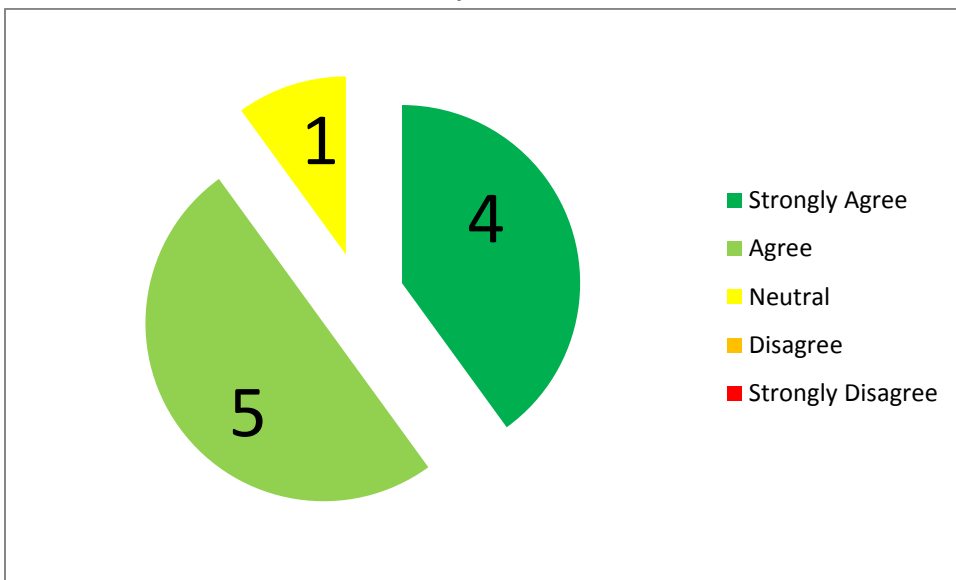
Photoshop Design: Oct 28 & Nov 4th Workshop

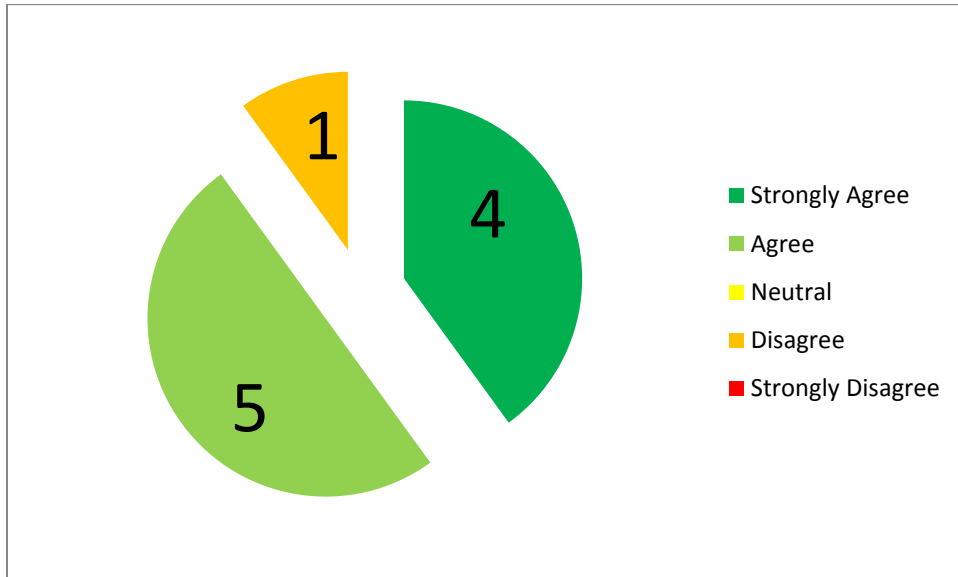
1. Are you an MI or MMSt student?



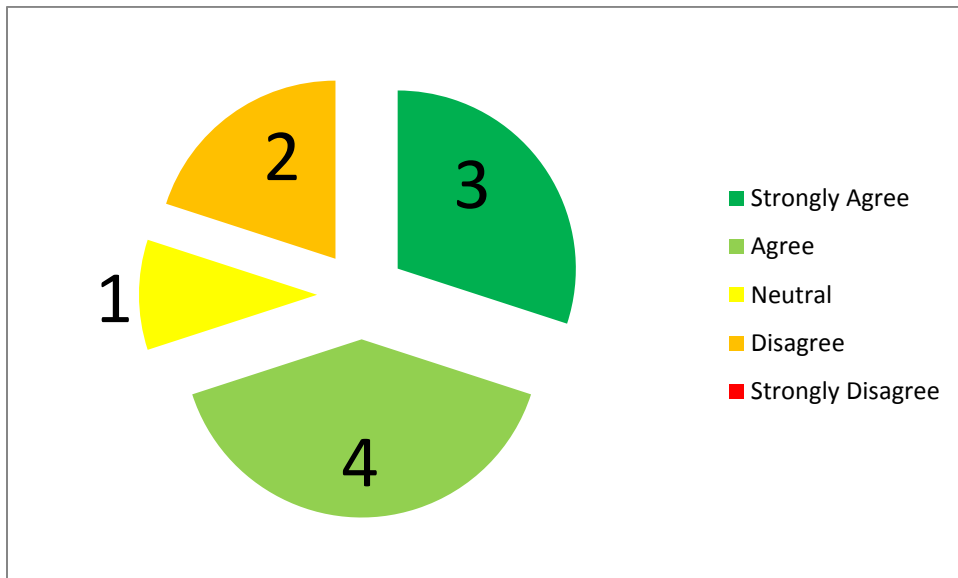
2. The course met its stated aims and objectives.



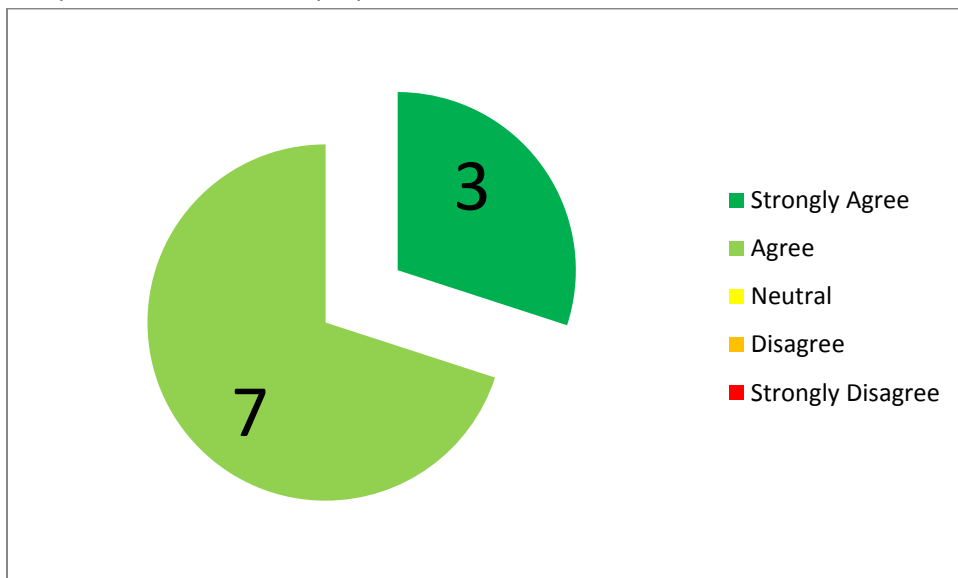
3. The workshop material was presented in a clear and organized manner.



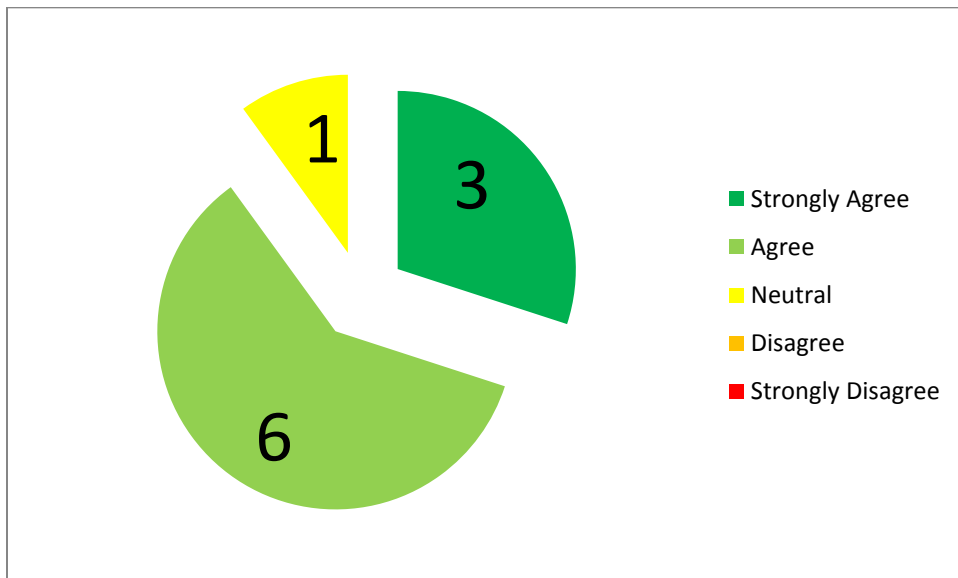
4. The workshop was paced appropriately.



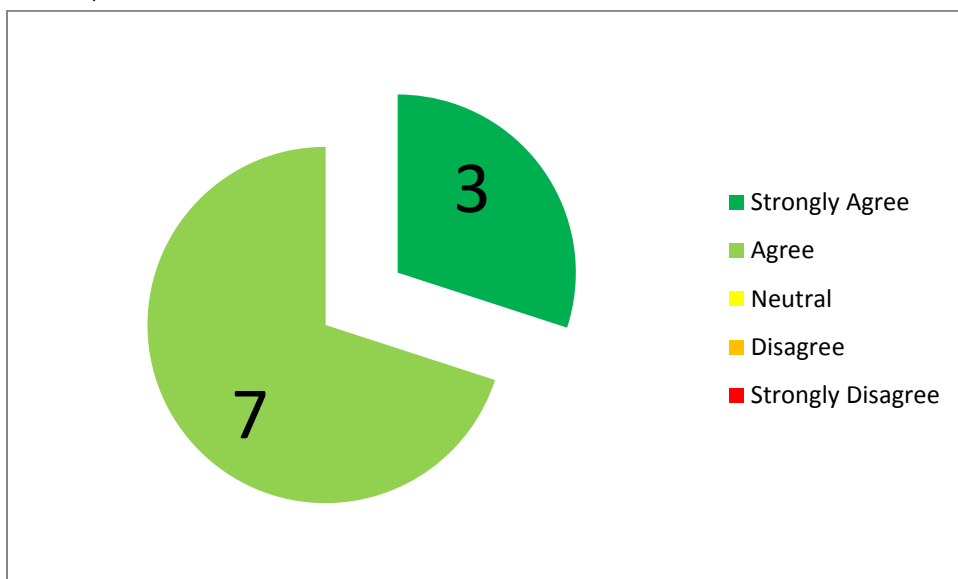
5. The presenters were well prepared.



6. The presenters responded to questions in an informative, appropriate and satisfactory manner.



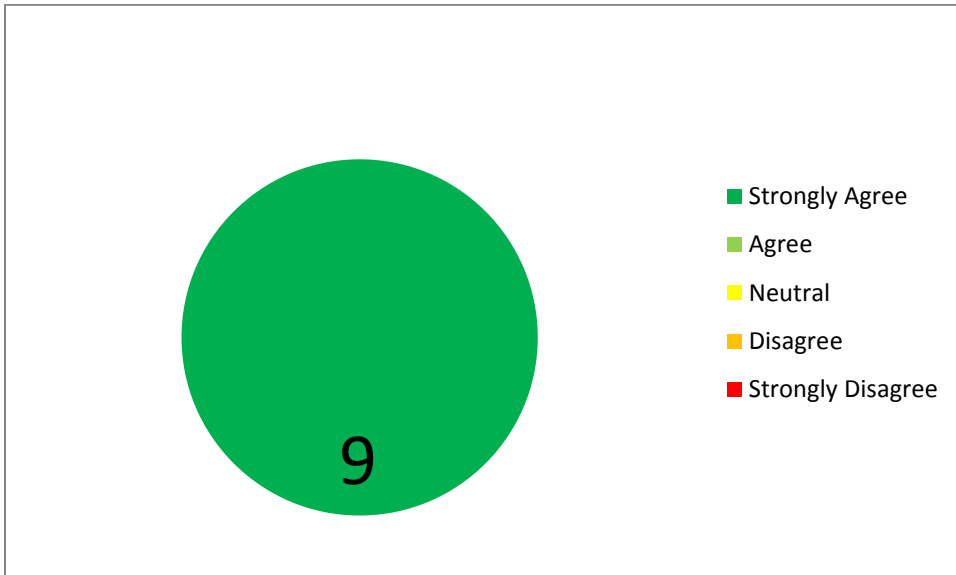
7. Overall, the sessions were informative and valuable.
