1.0 Call to Order

Meeting comes to order at 4:15 PM.

2.0 MISC Updates

2.1 COVID-19 Resources

MISC and MI students compiled a giant google sheet with resources for MI students getting through COVID-19. Check our website for more info Accessibility Interests WG is starting a delivery service for students who need it, as well as chats for students who are feeling isolated. Mental Health Committee is also working on initiatives.

2.2 MISC 2019/2020 Recap

Tons of events planned by Social Committee, PD Committee, Mental Health Committee, Survey Committee. End of Year Formal is tentatively happening, but likely will be cancelled. Employer showcase has also been cancelled. Last event before everything began to shut down was the Librarian's Guide to Homelessness training with Ryan Dowd, organized by our Mental Health Committee in collaboration with Daisy Dowdall.

MISC Working Groups also hosted planned lots of events. AIWG hosted a fall brownbag series; winter term an Inclusive libraries talk, Star Trek viewing party. DWG hosted SYLLA-BYE (diversifying syllabi in the iSchool) destruct-a-thon and many others (see slide deck). Part-time students working group hosted fall social, winter board game night was cancelled.

Tech fund is not accepting new funding requests this year. Wrapping up budget in coming weeks. Working with Inforum.

3.0 Student Services Update with Steff Rose

- Finalizing awards for students in concentrations that have not historically had awards given to them at convocation.
- Fol is now locked to public access, still has fob access. Student Services is still committed to getting necessary tech to students, though on a one-by-one basis and with minimal contact.
- Beginning a "Virtual Inforum" sharing information, creating chatrooms, delivery of online programs, online brownbags, expanding our opportunities to utilize technology available to us. Student Services will be in contact with MISC and MUSSA leadership about these.

4.0 Bissell Renovation Update with Dean Duff

Let the light in and the ideas out. Renovating floors 1-3, hiring an architect starting in September to work on very detailed plans. Front door entering first floor. First floor will also have lockers, gallery space, classrooms? Second floor would have balcony that looks down. Building is a heritage building, so FoI will have to get permission on some things.

5.0 Question Period

MISC

Question about whether a new executive position on MISC could be proposed.

• Not for this upcoming year, but could be proposed for consideration by 2020/2021 council for the 2021/2022 year.

STUDENT SERVICES

Question about students in housing who are being asked to leave, but cannot because they are international.

• Understanding is that they can stay. Students are not required to move, they should be allowed to stay.

Question about financial assistance grants.

• Students with financial needs should contact Sherry. We will be using the Emergency Bursary protocol.

Question about summer courses and practicum placements.

• Will discuss summer courses in the coming weeks as we monitor situation. Pretty confident that they will be online. Practicum and co-op placements rely on external partners, everything is uncertain right now. Plan for Faculty is to have a plan in place by April 6.

BUILDING RENO

Question about additional washrooms with powered doors.

• Feasibility design was looking at putting additional washrooms on every floor.

Question about building reno timeline.

• Will be quite long. Will have to hire architect, go through layers in city. Unlikely (probably impossible) to have any construction before next summer, likely summer after.

Question about classrooms and labs being moved.

• Students will still have access to classrooms on floors 4-5, but not big enough to accommodate everyone.

OTHER

Question about convocation contingency plans.

• Nothing finalized yet, Discussions about convocation will be happening, but nothing is decided at the moment

Question about whether Inforum Users' Advisory Group is continuing.

• So far not finalized (currently no director of the Inforum). Students have come forward with requests for [writing center?] and labs. Unsure who should oversee these changes. Once these changes are in place, there will be an advisory group on what these spaces become.

Question about continuation of focus groups: Will there continue to be online focus groups for self-study?

• Still ironing out details.

Question about how feedback from focus groups will be used and implemented.

• All of the feedback will be used as we write the self-study. The self-study is a self-assessment: describe changes, how population has changed, etc. Also look at recommendations of previous self-study and how we have addressed them so far. Feedback are key indicators of how our programs are improving. Also looking for things that can be addressed. Looking at hiring more faculty in areas that are growing. Also concrete suggestions in the LIS program.

Question about diversity of focus groups.

• Deeply concerned about diversity in concentrations, interested in having more diverse faculty. Has met with local industry leaders to discuss how to attract more diverse students. Providing more mechanisms to collect feedback enables more diverse feedback. We could even have a focus group on the issue of diversity if that would help.




